Letter from the Executive Director

In its 37th year of operation, Gateway180 truly expanded into becoming a full service housing services agency. In 2013, the agency continued improving its service offerings to families by expanding core programs for women with the addition of our “Skills 4 Success” classes. The agency created and opened more housing programs, doubling our daily client base. We owned the distinction of being the only agency in Missouri that keeps any composition of families together, and continued being able to operate the largest 24 hour family emergency shelter in the state.

In 2013, Gateway180 was pleased to have earned four stars on Charity Navigator. This is a strong indicator that the agency is being a good steward of the funding we receive. The agency was able to adopt a balanced budget for 2014, and will again for 2015. These financial indicators are necessary for the agency to continue its important work. With the Federal Shutdown in the fall of 2013, Gateway180's leadership realized the importance of diversifying funding and focusing on rebuilding financial reserves as the agency expanded its programmatic offerings.

The agency continued its important work of helping families experiencing homelessness to become re-housed. In the past three years, the agency has gone from operating one housing program (the emergency shelter) to overseeing four distinct programs: 24 hour family emergency shelter, transitional housing, rapid rehousing and permanent supportive housing. The agency's newest program, Rapid Rehousing, enabled us to move chronically homeless families from the streets directly into their own apartments. Through this program, we worked with 26 other partners in providing supportive services ensuring that the 11 men, 11 women and 11 children served through Gateway180 had the tools they needed to remain in stable housing. Through our four housing programs, Gateway180 provided almost 74,422 bed nights of shelter in 2013.

It is with great gratitude to our donors and supporters that our mission of serving families continues. On behalf of the women, men and children served by our housing agency, we thank you for your kind, selfless and on-going support of Gateway180.

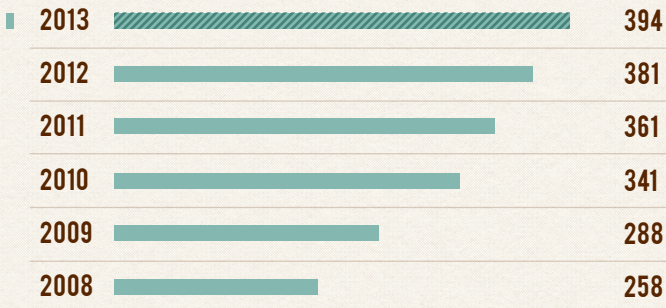

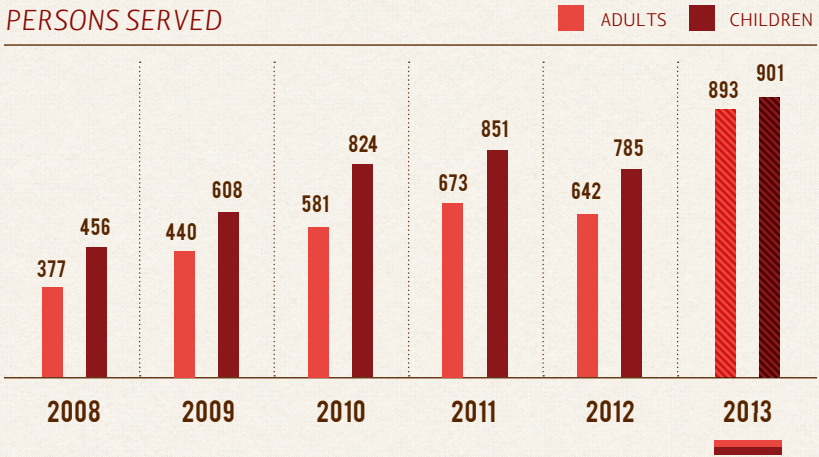

PERSONS SERVED

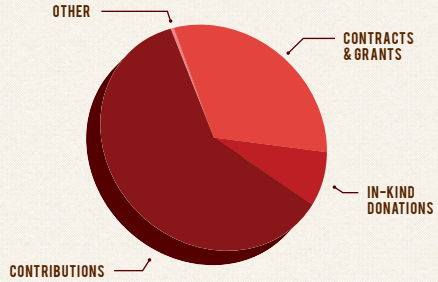

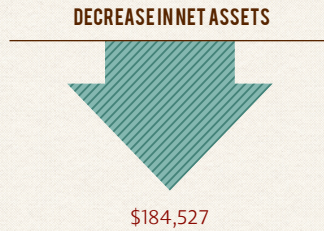
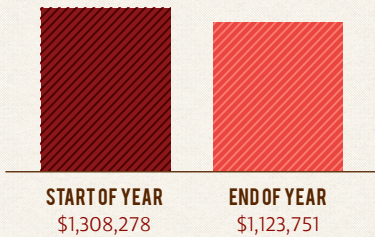


2013 OPERATING EXPENSES
